The Big Questions: Why is it important not to waste water? How can we use water responsibly?

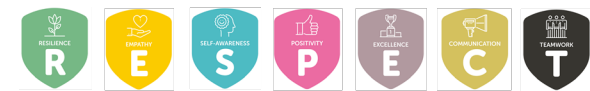
I can describe how we can use water responsibly and understand the importance of doing this.
