Why is the Bible special for Christians?



The Big Picture

Children learn about the Bible as a special book for Christians and reflect on which books are special to them and why.

They learn how the Bible is treated and used by Christians and learn what the Bible teaches Christians about God.

Bible	An important religious text for Christians.
Gospel	The name given to each of the four books in the New Testament that detail the life of Jesus.
moral	The moral of a story is the lesson the story teaches and how to behave in the world.

Key Learning

Children learn about the Bible as a special book for Christians, and reflect on which books are special to them and why

They reflect on which books / stories are special to Christians and why.

They learn how the Bible is treated and used by Christians

They learn what the Bible teaches Christians about God.

Expectations

Knowledge and Understanding: Identify some of the beliefs of Christianity and Hinduism and retell some stories within Christianity and Hinduism

Identify some ways in which Christians and Hindus worship and celebrate special events

Use some religious words

Show some awareness of how some aspects are the same in both Christianity and Hinduism e.g. both have a special founder, stories, ways of worship

Critical Thinking: Express their views and give simple reasons in response to their learning about the beliefs, teachings and practices in Christianity and Hinduism

Personal Reflection: Reflect on their own beliefs, values and feelings in relation to what they have learnt about Christianity and Hinduism.
