- Advent is the period of four Sundays and weeks before Christmas.
- It means coming in Latin this is the coming of Jesus into the world. Christians use advent to prepare and remember the real meaning of Christmas.

- Germany: decorate trees; according to legend the rivers turn to wine and animals speak
- Denmark: Christmas Eve feast with a special rice pudding dessert
- Japan: decorate trees and exchange gifts; turkey for dinner
- Australia: gatherings in gardens or on the beach; seafood and cold meats for dinner
