Ten Commandments	These are a set of rules that God gave Moses. God wants Christians to follow these.
Jewish belief:	
• <u>Tikkun olam</u>	Doing acts of kindness to help repair the world.
• <u>Tzedek</u>	A charity that helps very poor people.
Muslim belief:	
• <u>Zakah</u>	Muslims give 2.5% of their earnings to charity.
• Christian Aid	A Christian charity that helps very poor people.
Golden Rule	This is important for both religious and non-religious people.
