RE Focus:

How and why do people care for others?

Year 4

Term: 3A

Core Knowledge and Understanding

Describe some ways in which Christians and Sikhs help others and the difference this makes to people and link this to appropriate religious teaching and beliefs.

Identify some patterns between the religious and non-religious worldviews studied by comparing similarities and differences.

Ask and explore relevant questions (eg Who should care for others? Do only religious people show care?), express their opinions and support these with plausible reasons.

Recognise that others may hold different opinions.

What did Jesus teach about helping others?

How do Christians help others today?

How and why do Sikhs show sewa?

How can our school community care for others?

What I Should Know

How Christians today follow the commandment of Jesus (love God and love your neighbour as you love yourself) and the Ten Commandments; how Christians demonstrate love, charity, forgiveness in action e.g. work of local church, organisations and Christian charities (e.g. Salvation Army, CAFOD) and individual Christians.

How Sikhs follow and live by Sikh moral codes and how these are shown by individuals and the community e.g. langar meal, vand chhakna (sharing), sewa (selfless service).
