Palm Sunday	Palm Sunday is the Sunday before Easter. It is the day when Christians remember Jesus Christ's arrival in Jerusalem a few days before he was killed.
The Last Supper	The last supper was the last meal Jesus shared with his disciples before his arrest and crucifixion.
Crucifixion	The death of Jesus on the cross.

Key Learning
