**Currency:** Indian Rupee

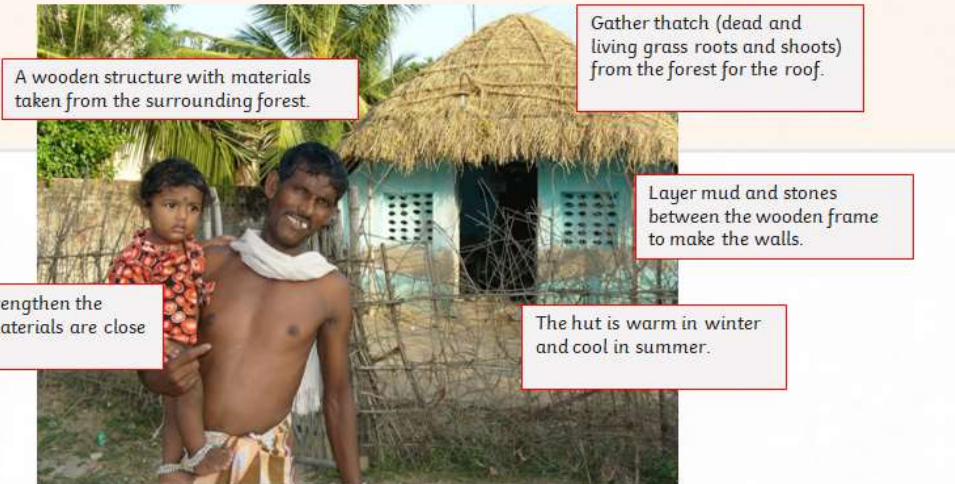
**Language:** Many different languages are spoken in India including, Hindi, Bengali, Telugu, Marathi, Tamil, Urdu, Gujarati and Kannada

**What Is It Like to Live in Chembakolli?**



A wooden structure with materials taken from the surrounding forest.

Gather thatch (dead and living grass roots and shoots) from the forest for the roof.

Layer mud and stones between the wooden frame to make the walls.

The hut is warm in winter and cool in summer.
