Term: 2

Children will explore different media to create collage and 3D form. Looking at these techniques through the animal kingdom.

### Exploring and developing ideas (ONGOING)

Record and explore ideas from first hand observation, experience and imagination. Ask and answer questions about the starting points for their work, and develop their ideas.

Explore the differences and similarities within the work of artists, craftspeople and designers in different times and cultures. Review what they and others have done and say what they think and feel about it. E.g. Annotate sketchbook

### Textiles/Collage

Use a variety of techniques, naming the tools and materials they have used. Develop skills in stitching. Cutting and joining. Experiment with a range of media.

### 3d Form

Join clay adequately and work reasonably independently. Construct a simple clay base for extending and modelling other shapes. Make a simple papier mache object.
