Core Knowledge and Understanding

- The nature of God as creator, ruler, provider, just, loving. Shown through metaphors for God: Potter, Father, Rock, Shepherd, Shield.
- The otherness of God (transcendent) who inspires awe, wonder, devotion.
- Introduction to Trinity: creator God, loving God, powerful God.
- How belief in God will affect Christians e.g. prayer.
- Introduction to how Christian values will affect views on moral issues – environment.

The Big Picture

This unit will build on work from KS1 work in relation to Christian Harvest and belief in God as creator. There is some reference to how these beliefs are reflected in Christian values and practice, but their main impact will be dealt with in other units. Throughout this unit, pupils will be encouraged to ask puzzling/interesting questions and suggest reasons. These can be used for final unit discussion and display.
