Wider Learning

Fire Safety in the Home: In this activity, children have a tick list of ways to keep our homes safe from fire risks. Children can tick those that they and their family do, then choose one of them to start doing in their home.

Strangers and Safer Strangers: Encourage children think about strangers that we can trust, such as new teachers at school, police officers, nurses and doctors. Children draw a safe stranger and write a sentence about them.
