Year 3 Curriculum Newsletter - Summer Term 3A

Welcome to the Summer term! This half term, we will be taking part in Science week (19th May- 23rd May) and are looking forward to taking part in lots of Science activities. We also have lots more exciting curriculum learning planned for this half-term and greatly value your support as a parent/ carer. We would like to share our curriculum coverage for this half-term.

English - Pupils will be using their skills they have been taught this year in poetry to write their own poems based on a shape. They will be taught the skills for writing a newspaper report and apply these to events around school.

Maths – Our mathematicians will develop their fluency and reasoning skills through solving problems using fractions, mass and capacity. Please support us at home by ensuring your child completes their maths homework and accesses TT-Rockstars.

Science – Children will develop their knowledge about plants. They will be looking at how plants grow in different environments and completing their own experiments when working scientifically.

RE – Children will learn more about Sikhism. They will learn about the Gudwara which is the place of worship for Sikhs.

PE - Pupils will be continuing to develop their Tennis skills and learning the skills of skipping.

Design Technology – Children will learn about an Edible garden. This will link with our unit of work in Science on plants. Children will be using things that are grown to make different food.

Geography – Children will learn about the Biomes around the world. They will look at similarities and differences between them.

Computing – Pupils will develop their understanding of Publisher.

PSHEE & Relationships - Children will discuss how thinking positively can help our wellbeing.
