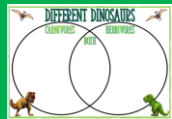


# Dinosaurs

Salt Dough Fossils

## Ingredients

- 2 cups wheat flour
- 1 cup salt
- 1/2 cup warm water
- Plastic dinosaurs

Mix the flour, salt, and warm water together to make the salt dough. Roll it into balls. Press the dinosaurs into the dough. Bake at 150C degrees for 2 -3 hours or until hard. Try salt dough bones too!

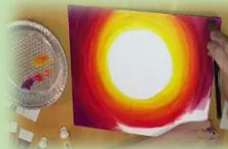
## Prehistoric Pasta
