Watch the video, where you will hear Chapter 5 being read to you. There will be some questions to answer during this video. You may choose to write your answers to these questions here. If you decide to do this, pause the video to give yourself time to write.

1. Look at Goldlaw’s speech on pages 41 and 42. What do you think is changing about Goldlaw’s character?
2. Find and copy some evidence from page 41 which tells you that Goldlaw is changing the way he speaks and the sounds that he makes.
3. What caused the rocks to fall?
4. What prediction do you make about Goldlaw’s character in the final chapter?

After the Video

Answer these questions after watching the video. Look carefully in the eBook for the answers and use what you have learned in the first section.

5. What type of animal is Yash taking care of?

6. Why didn't Goldlaw cancel the detonation before he went up the mountain?

7. At the bottom of page 43, there is an ellipsis (...). Why do you think the author has put this punctuation here?

8. Whose voice floats towards Yash at the very end of the chapter? How do you know who this is?

9. What does the author mean when they describe 'a furious battle taking place behind the man's eyes'? (p.42)

10. Can you think of any other stories where the villain is taught a lesson? Compare this book with another one you have read.
