

Food Bank

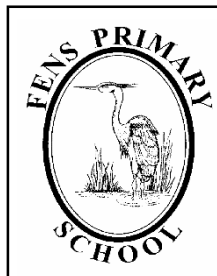
After the success of previous years, we are hoping to support our local food bank again, as part of our harvest celebrations.

Trussell Trust foodbanks provide three days of emergency food to local individuals and families in crisis. Frontline care professionals including health visitors, social workers and school liaison officers refer people who are facing hunger to the foodbank. As well as receiving nutritionally balanced, non-perishable food parcels, people visiting the foodbank are welcomed with a cup of tea, listened to and signposted to agencies who are able to help resolve the underlying cause of the problem.

By donating to the foodbank you can help support local people in crisis. Following are the types of food our local foodbank would like: Pasta sauce, Tinned meat, Tinned fruit, Tinned sponge pudding, Longlife Juice, UHT or Powder Milk, Sugar (500g), Biscuits or snacks, Tinned vegetables and Tea or coffee.
