Christmas Discos

At present, following a significant drop in rates, Covid numbers are once again rising locally, and are still classed as very high. However, and unless advised otherwise, we will be holding our Christmas discos! Please note the following in that we will be having them during the day on Tuesday, November 30th. There will be no charge for this. We will have Reception at 9.30-10.15, Y5&6 10.30-11.15, Y1&2 1.30-2.15 and Y3&4 2.25-3.10. Nursery will hold their own Disco in the Bousfield Learning Suite on the same day. Each child will be provided with a snack pack (including Nursery on their day) and they will be allowed to come to school in their disco clothes. As well as the discos, we are still at present planning to have live audience performances and the times are still as detailed two weeks ago. Tickets costing £1 each must be paid for in advance on Schoolmoney prior to each performance, and cannot be paid on the door (this facility is now live and if anyone has any login problems then please contact the school). We politely remind you that tickets will be limited to two tickets per family, per show, and not two tickets per child. No additional tickets will be released for these performances. Once paid for, tickets will be given to the named child the tickets have been paid for and sent home with them, so please check school bags. The purchasing of tickets will be monitored, and should you have more than one child in a particular show, and more than two tickets are purchased, the additional tickets will be cancelled, and refunds given. In the unfortunate event that we are forced to cancel performances all monies will be refunded (please note that these performances may be cancelled at short notice depending on Covid and relevant up to date guidance). Tickets are not interchangeable between performances and audience members must purchase tickets for the shows as detailed in the above table. Due to child safeguarding issues would you please also note that no photographs or video recording will be allowed during the performance. All monies raised will go directly to our children to provide them with the fantastic experiences they receive here at Fens Primary School.
