#### Attendance

Although last week's attendance is still above our 96% target for Reception to Y6, it has dropped from 97.5% to 96.1%, which is mainly due to term-time holidays. The knock-on effect sees a decline in our year-to-date attendance percentage dropping from 97.78% to 97.45%.

This decline also extends to Nursery with a weekly drop from 96.3% to 90.0%, and a year-to-date of 95.2%, which is down from 96.4%. This in turn takes us below our 96% target.
