Tickets costing £1 each must be paid for in advance on ParentPay prior to each performance, and cannot be paid on the door (if anyone has any login problems then please contact the school). Due to fire regulations, we are unable to release additional tickets for these performances. Once paid for, tickets will be sent home, so please check school bags. **ParentPay will go live by close of play tomorrow 11.11.25.**

The purchasing of tickets will be monitored, and should you have more than one child in a particular show, and more than two tickets are purchased, the additional tickets will be cancelled, and refunds given. Tickets are not interchangeable between performances and audience members must purchase tickets for the shows as detailed in the above table.

**Due to child safeguarding issues would you please also note that no photographs or video recording will be allowed during the performances.**

### Christmas Disco (01.12.25)

For those wanting to attend, children can bring a change of disco clothes to change into on the afternoon.

Children not wishing to go will go home at normal time as usual (After School Club will be in the Heron Room that night). Reception, Y1 and Y2 pupils will dance first and then go for their refreshments, before being collected to go home from the KS1 playground at 5pm. Y3-Y6 pupils will have their refreshments first and then go into the dance hall before being collected from the KS2 playground at 5pm.

There will additional drinks available throughout.

The cost for entry and refreshments will be **£3 per child and must be paid online via ParentPay**. Children not attending the disco, or After School Club, must be collected and taken home at 3.25pm. **ParentPay will go live by close of play tomorrow 11.11.25.**
