#### Attendance

Even though our year-to-date attendance stands at 97.06%, which is well above our 96% whole school target (Reception to Y6), we are still seeing an on-going decline overall.

In addition, and for the first time this academic year, our weekly attendance has dropped below our 96% target and stands at 95.1%. This is higher than the same week in previous years, so is a huge positive, but we are seeing a decrease, which we aim to avoid.

Our Nursery weekly attendance is up slightly from 90.0%, to 90.3%, although the year-to-date of 94.2% is another decline from 95.2% last week, which was down from 96.4% the week before that. This is well below our target.
