If we are not able to contact anyone, we may carry out home visits to establish the reason for absence.

Following guidance and expectations given in today's assembly, our Head Boy, Head Girl and Y6 monitors are going on first, so they can offer support when performing their duties and each class will then have time with staff, before we revert to a timetable seeing each class having a day when they will have access to this at playtime and lunchtime.
