Snap Chat

We wanted to make you aware about the changes to the snap map setting on the Snap Chat app. If snap maps is turned on, the more you zoom into the map, the more information is displayed about your current location. At the highest level of zoom, it displays your address and even your house number. As you move, the app will then track your movements. If you, or any of your children use Snap Chat, please be aware of this when enabling the snap map setting. Also, please be aware of who you, and your children, are friends with on Snap Chat.
