

Autumn

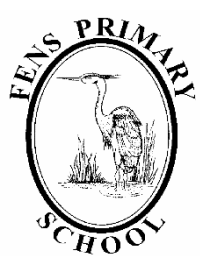

Covid-19

We politely wish to reinforce the below information:

If a child has any symptoms of Covid-19 (a high temperature, a new, continuous cough, or a loss or change to their sense of smell or taste) they should remain at home and should get a **PCR** test. Please note: a negative result on a lateral flow test is not sufficient to prove they are negative, and it is not recommended that children below the age of 12 take lateral flow tests. Following Government guidance, which has been the case for a long time now, school will not accept negative lateral flow tests in allowing pupils who have displayed symptoms of Covid-19 back into school.
