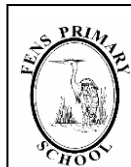


Science

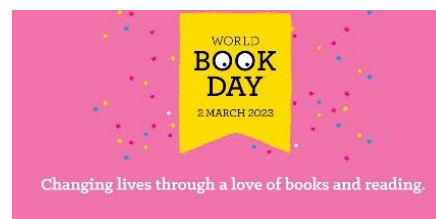
