Following discussions in a meeting held this morning, the Public Health Outbreak Control Team are happy with the control measures we have in place at Fens Primary School, as well as the progress school has made following a Covid-19 outbreak. Going forward, as we continue to monitor the progress of the outbreak, any child identified as a close contact with a positive case must take a PCR test and isolate at home until a negative result is reported. Evidence of this result must be shown to school for children to re-attend.
