

Wheelchair Basketball

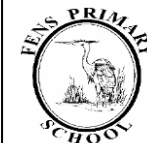
Well done to our Y5/6 pupils who attended a wheelchair basketball event on Monday afternoon. The event was hosted by St Hild's as part of the School Games Mark.
