Thank you to all of our families who were able to come along to our 'Share a Story with Me' sessions last week. The children were excited to have you there.



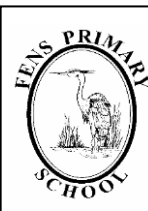
Drop Everything and Read

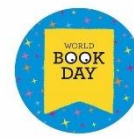


World Book 'Week' 2025
