

### Raffle

Each child has been given five sheets of raffle tickets to bring home, with each strip costing £1. If you would like to enter the raffle, payment must be made on schoolmoney. On the strip you send back, you must write on the name the ticket is for and the class your child is in (e.g. Y6 B, Reception C or Nursery M) on each individual ticket. 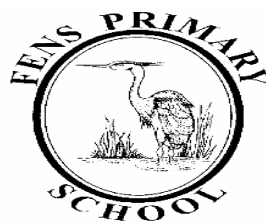
