In addition to showing exceptional skill on the day, and being amazing tennis players, their behaviour was excellent and they were fantastic ambassadors for the school!

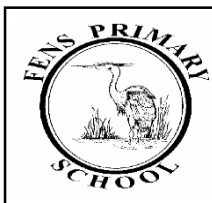
Attendance Officer
