## After School Club

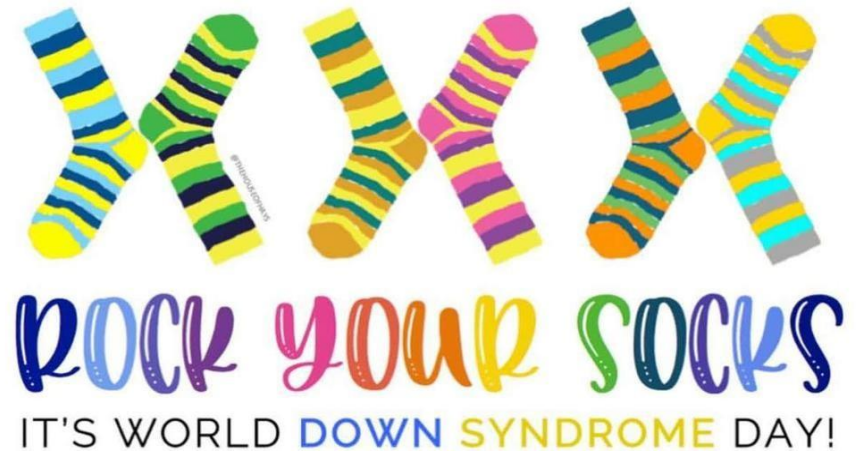
Places are now available for our After School Club. If you require any further information, or to book a place, please contact Mrs Green at the school office.
