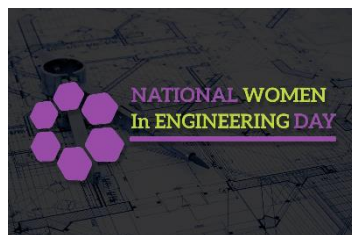


Aspire2Be
