Covid has had a huge impact on all of us during the last few years, but as things are moving forward, disruptions are becoming less and less and we are now looking forward to a new full year of exciting times in school for all children.

We want every child getting into school as much as they possibly can and with this in mind, we will be introducing 'You've Got To Be In To Win!'

Throughout the next academic year (**again, Starting on Friday September 2nd**), we will be introducing a variety of ways for children to be rewarded with strong school attendance.
