## Term Time holidays

As a school, we recommend you do not take your child out of school for holidays during term time. However, if you do take your child out of school for holidays, please make an appointment with Mr Connor to complete the relevant holiday request forms prior to the holiday. Please note that if your child's attendance should drop below 90% in the 39 school weeks prior to this absence, the Local Authority attendance team will be notified and a penalty notice could be issued. The penalty notices issued are £60 per parent, per child, if paid within 21 days. This penalty notice will double if paid between 22 and 28 days after the penalty notice has been issued. e.g. A two-parent family with two children receive 4x £60 notices, as each parent would receive one notice per child. The family would need to pay £240 to the Local Authority if paid within 21 days or £480 if paid between 22 and 28 days. Where payment is not received within 28 days, the case is forwarded to court.
