Bikes and scooters left at the start of the day during drop-off time, must be collected at home time and not left over night, as we do not want to attract any unwanted attention out of school opening hours. If you would like to use a chain for added security during the day, this is fine, but it would be wise to label/add something to you bike or scooter, especially as there may be two/three things the same.

We must also point out that school will not be responsible for any theft or damage whilst scooters and bikes are on the school site. The children have been informed in assembly to play away from the shelters and racks to avoid injury and we ask that children are collected first at home time (the normal routine) before the bikes and scooters.

We also ask that children enter the playground in a sensible manner and are mindful of other children and adults.

Please also note that as e-Scooters are not legally permitted on public roads and paths and children must be 16 years old to ride one, e-Scooters are not permitted in school.
