Year 4 Curriculum Newsletter – Summer Term 1

We have more exciting curriculum learning planned for this half-term and greatly value your support as a parent/carer. We would like to share our curriculum coverage for this half-term.

English - Pupils will be writing their own story based around the book *Street Child*. Please support us with reading by regularly listening to your child read aloud at home.

Maths – Our mathematicians will continue to develop their fluency and reasoning skills through solving problems about decimals and money. Please support us at home by ensuring your child completes their maths homework.

Science – Year 4 scientists will develop their knowledge about electricity.

RE – Year 4 will be developing their understanding of how and why people show care for others.

PE - Pupils will be developing their rounders technique.

Computing – Pupils will be learning about data logging and why this is important.

PSHEE & Relationships – Children will discuss the importance of sleep and its effects on the body as well as how to look after themselves through making healthy choices.

Geography- Our Year 4 geographers will be exploring energy and water, looking at The Aswan Dam.

Art- Children will be using different mediums to create a range of landscape settings.

French – Children will be practicing their speaking, listening, reading and writing skills through learning about the weather.

Reminders

- Year 4 children benefit greatly from reading every day at home, especially with an adult to hear and question them. Children will receive Reading Raffle stamps for every adult signature in their Home/School Reading Record.
- It will also be hugely beneficial for Year 4 children to go on TTRS at home as often as they can, in preparation for the Multiplication Check in June.
- Homework will be given out on a Friday and needs to be returned to school by the following Wednesday.
- Spellings will be given out on a Monday and spelling tests will take place each Friday.
- PE will take place on Monday and Wednesday of each week – please can children have their PE kits in school.
